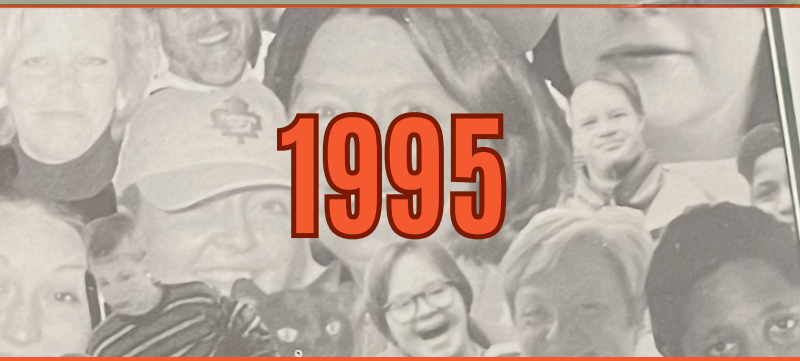


Celebrating 30 Years

Movin' Out was founded by a group of parents searching for a place for their young adult children with disabilities to live independently.



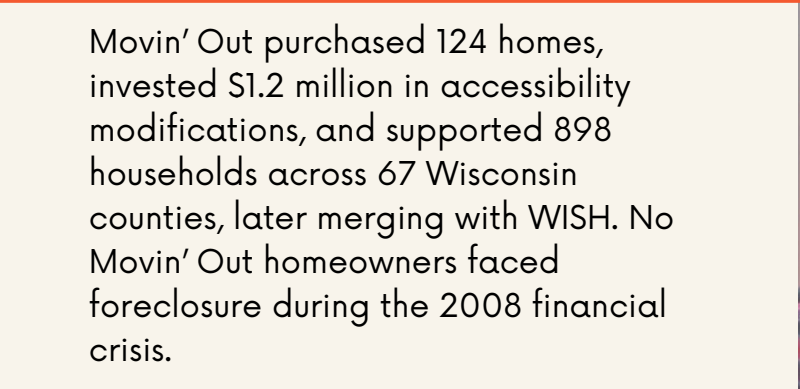
2005

Movin' Out Inc. merges with WISH (Wisconsin Initiatives in Sustainable Housing Inc.)



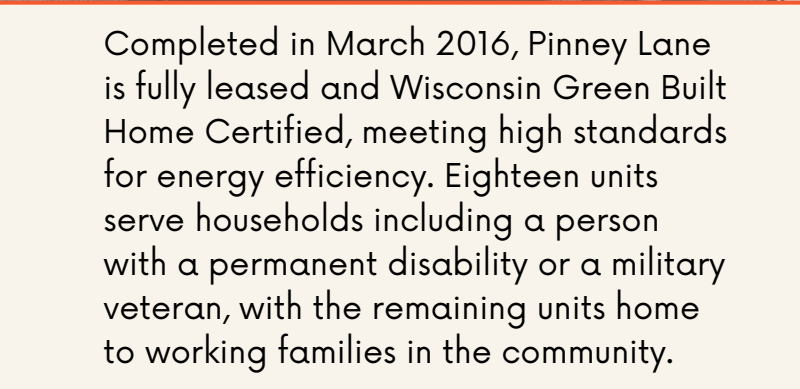

Movin' Out purchased 124 homes, invested \$1.2 million in accessibility modifications, and supported 898 households across 67 Wisconsin counties, later merging with WISH. No Movin' Out homeowners faced foreclosure during the 2008 financial crisis.



2009

Honoring excellence: Arcand Award recipients included Sandler Bell, LOV Dane, Tim Radelet and Marcie – a huge milestone for Movin' Out along with the recipients.



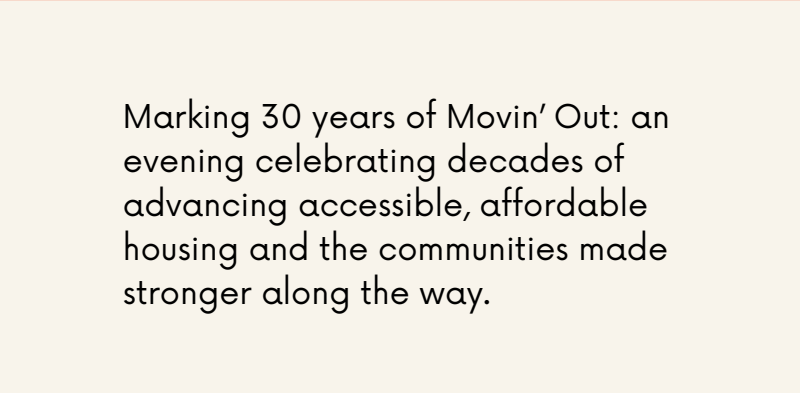
2016

Completed in March 2016, Pinney Lane is fully leased and Wisconsin Green Built Home Certified, meeting high standards for energy efficiency. Eighteen units serve households including a person with a permanent disability or a military veteran, with the remaining units home to working families in the community.



2024

Movin' Out's 2024 impact had hundreds of households supported through homeownership, counseling, and accessibility services, alongside continued growth in supportive housing and strong housing stability across Wisconsin.
